Someone who wishes to enter undetected may choose to disguise themselves as an ordinary worker, and will escape the notice of guards monitoring the video security system. In this case, you will require access control systems to prevent unauthorized access to your premises. Access control systems involve security systems that do not allow entry through doors unless a person is able to present a valid form of identification. This usually comes in the form of a card or a code that has to be keyed into the system before the protected door will open.

You need only provide employees with a form of identification to pass through the access control systems, and you greatly reduce the likelihood that someone will gain unauthorized entry to your premises. Access control systems are already widely in use in offices and other compounds worldwide, and they have proved to be enormously successful. Most of the offices and compounds protected by these systems contain sensitive information, whether they deal with business or dangerous chemicals, they all rely on access control systems to prevent unauthorized access.
